



High Maturity Seminar

The CMMI® High Maturity Seminar builds participants' knowledge and skills necessary for leading organizations through successful implementation of Maturity Level 4 and 5 Process Areas. Foundational organizational elements supporting evolution of high maturity practices and key attributes of high maturity organizations are explained in addition to a detailed walkthrough of the high maturity practices. Participant provided data is used where ever possible to illustrate concepts.

This seminar assumes foundational Maturity Level 2 and 3 knowledge is in place. Given the current maturity of the organization and the skills of the process group members, the High Maturity Seminar should include individuals involved in process improvement or definition who need to expand their knowledge level of high maturity practices. Participants learn about the components needed to build a successful High Maturity process improvement program. Exercises focus on building skills to identify and manage high maturity implementation issues, barriers, and risks that can be used to develop a focused process improvement plan.
