



## Appraisal Method Training (AMT)

AMT prepares participants to be team members on an appraisal team or help them support preparations for a model based appraisal. The appraisal team techniques and methods for conducting Appraisal Requirements for CMMI® (ARC) compliant appraisals are the focus of this course. ISD's Comprehensive Appraisal Method (CAM V1.3), consistent with SCAMPI® v1.3, is used as a foundational method that can be used with any reference model. The course provides fundamental appraisal concepts needed for an individual to perform as an effective team member on an ARC compliant Class A, B or C appraisal team. This course includes portions of a guided case study to simulate activities in an actual appraisal. The interactive lectures and exercises use the simulation and Appraisal Wizard® to further facilitate their learning experience.

The course objectives include preparing students to effectively participate as team members, understand how to support the appraisal plan goals and objectives, objective evidence data collection, data consolidation and ratings.
